Possibility Projects must be submitted a minimum of 30 Days prior to event.

Creating a Successful Possibility Project

A Possibility Project is a way to open doors and expand what's possible. To make your project meaningful and impactful:

- Choose an activity that reflects your team's energy, strengths, and audience
- Set a clear fundraising goal and timeline to guide your efforts
- Share your "why" personal connections to Aspire's mission inspire others to give
- Promote your project across multiple channels, including email, social media, and word of mouth
- Be transparent about how funds raised will support Aspire
- Celebrate and share your impact to encourage others to get involved

Your Role as a Possibility Project Organizer

As the organizer, you lead the vision and execution of your event. To ensure alignment and success, we ask that you:

- Submit an application and receive approval before promoting your event
- Clearly identify Aspire as the beneficiary, not the host or sponsor
- Manage all event logistics, expenses, promotion, and execution
- Ensure your event reflects Aspire's mission and values
- Use Aspire's name and logo only with prior approval and without alteration
- Share any materials referencing Aspire for review before distribution

- Clearly communicate the portion of proceeds benefiting Aspire
- Submit all funds within the agreed-upon timeframe after your event
- Keep Aspire informed of any significant updates or changes

- Aspire is unable to solicit sponsors or donations on your behalf
- Aspire's tax-exempt status and EIN may not be used by third-party organizers
- Only donations made directly to Aspire are eligible for tax receipts
- All events must comply with applicable local, state, and federal laws

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- Aspire reserves the right to decline, cancel, or withdraw support from events that do not align with our mission or guidelines
